CAMP DIRECTOR

DAN NESSLER, Head Softball Coach

Dan Nessler enters his third season as the Head Softball Coach in 2018-19. During Nessler's first two seasons, the Vikings have qualified for the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference (UMAC) postseason tournament twice. Prior to Nessler's arrival, the Vikings last advanced to postseason play in 2013.

In 2018, the Vikings continued to show improvement with Nessler in charge. The Vikings finished with an overall record of 17-19 and an impressive UMAC record of 10-6. The Vikings finished the postseason with a 2-2 record with wins over UW-Superior and Crown. Nessler coached two UMAC First Team All-Conference players and one Honorable Mention as well as one member of the All-Defensive Team. Nessler also recruited the UMAC Rookie of the Year in Sarah Presler.

In 2017, Nessler's first season at the helm, the Vikings more than doubled their win total from the previous year. The Vikings finished with an overall record of 15-24 and UMAC record of 8-8. In postseason play, the Vikings won their opening round game against UW-Superior before being eliminated from the tournament. The Vikings had one UMAC First Team All-Conference player, one Honorable Mention, and one All-Defensive player.

In two seasons, the Vikings have had three First Team All-Conference players, two Honorable Mention, and two All-Defensive players.

The Vikings have not only improved on the softball field, but in the classroom as well. In two seasons, the Vikings have had a total of 14 players receive Academic All-Conference honors. In 2018, the Vikings boasted 10 recipients with a team grade point average of 3.55.

Entering his third season as the softball coach, Nessler has put together a coaching staff that has many years of fastpitch coaching experience. Joining Nessler is Ashley Hanley, Brent Meshke, Gary Lunz, Mark Wiest, Megan Svir, and John Oothoudt to help the Bethany softball program compete for an UMAC Championship.
